



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Where do I park? Do I need to pay for parking?

- No. Parking is free around the stadium.

Where do I get in to the stadium for Berks Summer Fest?

- All guests will enter through the main stadium gates, to the right of the Ticket Office.
- Volunteers and VIPs will check in to the right of the Main Entrance.

Do I need to pay for tickets?

- No. This is a FREE family-friendly, community event! Bring your friends and family -- the more the merrier -- out to the ballpark for a fun afternoon and/or evening!
- All concerts are free and open to everyone.
- There is a charge for concessions, merchandise, and some activities.
- There is a registration fee for the Supportive Concepts Benefit Cornhole Tournament. Please register online no later than June 16th.

- No. Guests are not allowed on the field during the season. The stage will be located at second base, facing home plate. The grandstands will be open and the video boards on, so everyone will have a great view of the performances!

Can I bring a cooler with me?

- No, outside food and beverages are not allowed in the stadium. The stadium concession stands will be open with a variety of food and beverages available.

- No. Sorry, the pool is not open this weekend.
