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## CALL FOR ENTRIES

Berks Arts announces the 20th annual Frank Scott Memorial Art Show: The Art of Jazz. The Art of Jazz honors legendary local jazz musician, Frank Scott. The Art of Jazz exhibits annually with the Boscov's Berks Jazz Fest. Submission is open to artwork in all media.

### THEME

Celebrate Jazz. An open theme to express how jazz inspires and impacts art, music, and the community through your vision and creation.

\$500 First Place

\$200 Second Place

\$100 Third Place

Honorable Mentions or other awards considered at the discretion of the juror.

### EXHIBIT DATES

The exhibition runs March 9 - April 2, 2024 in the Schmidt Gallery, 2nd Floor of the GoggleWorks Center for the Arts and (optional) April 4-14, 2024 at the DoubleTree Hotel by Hilton as part of Berks Jazz Fest.

### COST & ENTRY

Entry fee is \$40 for first artwork, \$10 for additional artwork, up to three (3) pieces total. High school students and younger enter free of charge.

### AWARDS RECEPTION

Awards will be presented at the Berks Arts Awards Night on Thursday, April 4, 2024 in the Grand Ballroom of the Doubletree Hotel by Hilton Reading.



## SUBMISSION, SELECTION & ELIGIBILITY

Work must be submitted virtually no later than 11:59pm Wednesday, January 31, 2024. All work must be submitted using the provided digital submission form. Artists are encouraged to provide photos, videos, and links to allow the juror the best possible opportunity to examine, evaluate, and credit their artwork.

- All media are eligible for consideration.
- All work must be original and created within the past three years by the person submitting the work.
- Works previously submitted for The Art of Jazz will not be accepted.
- Art size may be limited to our ability to display.
- Work must be suitably mounted and ready to hang, including glass protection where appropriate. Clip frames and sawtooth hangers will not be accepted.
- All frames must have hanging hardware, including wire and safely cushioned glass. Indicate the top of each work by the proper placement (top/left/back) of your entry tag.
- For 3D work, place label on the base of the work.
- Exhibition acceptance and gallery placement will be determined by the juror.

## SALES & AUCTION

Artists are encouraged to participate in Art Sales and/or the Berks Jazz Fest Auction. Artist will receive 60% of revenue if artwork is sold or auctioned during the exhibit.



## MEET THE JUROR

MARK BISCHEL is an artist and teacher in New York City. His work has been represented in numerous solo and group exhibitions over his career and is such collections as Harvard Business School and the Artists' and the Fine Press Book Library of the National Gallery of Art.

His illustration work has also been recognized in The Society of Illustrators, Communication Arts magazine, Spectrum, and the Society of Illustrators of Los Angeles. Illustration clients include the Los Angeles Times, the Boston Globe, Simon & Schuster, Oxford University Press, NBC, and the Harry S. Truman Library.

He has taught drawing and illustration at the Kansas City Art Institute, The Maryland Institute, College of Art, and School of Visual Arts. He is currently an Assistant Professor in the Animated Arts Program at Kutztown University of Pennsylvania.
